AN ACT

Relating to highway surveys and construction.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

* Section 1. AS 19.10 is amended by adding a new section to read:

Sec. 19.10.260. REPLACEMENT OF PERMANENT MARKERS AND FILING OF RIGHT-OF-WAY MAP AFTER CONSTRUCTION. The department shall:

- (1) replace all permanent markers on private or municipal property that were destroyed or lost during highway construction, to permit persons to determine accurately new boundary lines resulting from the construction;
- (2) file in the local recording district, after completion of highway construction, an accurate right-of-way map that will contain sufficient engineering and survey information designating where the resulting boundary lines are located on private or municipal property along the highway.
