## AN ACT

Appropriating for extraordinary expenditures of boroughs, cities, municipal utility systems and school districts to meet the effects of the natural disaster of August 14, 1967; and providing for an effective date.

### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

\* Section 1. The sum of \$1,276,000 is appropriated from the general fund for the payment of extraordinary expenses incurred by boroughs, cities, municipal utility systems and school districts in the area declared as a natural disaster area by President Johnson's proclamation of August 17, 1967.

\* Sec. 2. This sum is available to pay extraordinary expenses of boroughs, cities, municipal utility systems and school districts brought on directly by the natural disaster, provided that extraordinary expenses otherwise compensated for may not be compensated for under this Act.

\* Sec. 3. This sum is available to pay part or all of the extraordinary expenses incurred from August 14, 1967, and shall remain available until June 30, 1969, and shall be distributed as follows:

City of Fairbanks . . . . .	\$ 1,052,500
City of Fairbanks, Municipal Utilities System . . . . .	98,500
Fairbanks North Star Borough . . . . .	99,000
City of Nenana . . . . .	26,000

\* Sec. 4. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage and approval or on the day it becomes law without approval.
