## AN ACT

Relating to the powers of designated judicial employees; and providing for an effective date.

### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

\* Section 1. AS 22.20 is amended by adding a new section to read:

Sec. 22.20.035. POWERS OF JUDICIAL EMPLOYEES. The clerk of a court, and a deputy clerk designated by order of a court, may exercise the powers of judicial officers specified in sec. 30(4), (5), (6) and (7) of this chapter, and other powers authorized by law.

\* Sec. 2. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage and approval or on the day it becomes law without approval.
