AN ACT

Relating to the time a child must be abandoned before an order terminating parental rights is entered; and providing for an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

Section 1. AS 47.10.080(c)(3)(B) is repealed and re-enacted to read:

(B) the child has been abandoned for a period of not less than six months by

- (1) both parents, or
- (ii) the surviving parent, or
- (iii) one parent if the other has been deprived of custody and visitation rights;

* Sec. 2. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage and approval or on the day it becomes law without approval.
