AN ACT

Relating to the ratification of capital improvement authorizations; and providing for an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

* Section 1. AS 15.15.030(11) is amended to read:

(11) When the legislature by law authorizes a state debt for capital improvements, the secretary of state shall place the question of whether the specific authorization shall be ratified by placing the ballot title and question on the next general election ballot, or on the special election ballot if a special election is held for the purpose of ratifying the state debt for capital improvements before the time of the next general election. Unless specifically provided otherwise in the act authorizing the debt, the ballot title shall, by the use of a few words in a succinct manner, indicate the general subject of the act. The question shall, by the use of a few sentences in a succinct manner, give a true and impartial summary of the Act authorizing the state debt. Provision shall be made for marking the question substantially as follows: "Bonds _____ Yes" or "Bonds _____ No," followed by an appropriate square.

* Sec. 2. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage and approval or on the day it becomes law without approval.
