AN ACT

Relating to the licensing of electrical contractors; and providing for an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

* Section 1. AS 08.40.190 is amended to read:

Sec. 08.40.190. EXCLUSION. This chapter does not apply to any person engaged in (1) electrical construction and maintenance of electrical wiring for the generation and distribution of electrical current where the wiring is an integral part of a system owned and operated by a public service corporation or the light and power department of a municipality and the work is performed by the employees of that public utility or municipality; (2) the operation, maintenance, or repair of telephone, telegraph, signal or communication systems, or of a television or radio broadcasting station; (3) the manufacture or repair of electrical apparatus or equipment; or (4) electrical work, the cost of which does not exceed \$5,000, involving residences or small commercial establishments in communities (A) which have a population of under 500, or (B) which are over 50 miles by air or water transportation from the business place of an electrical contractor licensed under this chapter; however, work within the exclusionary provisions of this subsection is subject to the inspection provisions of sec. 70 of this chapter and must follow the regulations regarding workmanship promulgated in the administrative code. A person who violates the provisions of this section is guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction is liable for a fine not to exceed \$300.

* Sec. 2. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage and approval or on the day it becomes law without approval.
