## AN ACT

Making it unlawful not to have local labor organizations in this state; and providing for a penalty.

### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

\* Section 1. AS 23.40 is amended by adding new sections to read:

Sec. 23.40.050. LOCAL LABOR ORGANIZATIONS. It shall be unlawful for any national or international labor organization having 100 or more members in good standing who reside or work in Alaska not to have at all times one or more duly chartered and established local organizations in this state.

Sec. 23.40.060. PENALTY. Any national or international labor organization which violates sec. 50 of this chapter, upon conviction, is punishable by a fine of not less than \$1,000 or more than \$10,000 for each offense.
