AN ACT

Relating to seal bounties; and providing for an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

* Section 1. AS 16.35.140 is amended to read:

Sec. 16.35.140. BOUNTY ON HAIR SEAL DECLARED. There is a bounty of \$3 on every hair seal inhabiting the inland and coastal waters of Alaska west of 159 degrees west longitude or north of 69 degrees north latitude, except the waters south of 58 degrees north latitude.

* Sec. 2. A bounty for animals removed from bounty payment by this Act may be paid only if the affidavit and claim for bounty required by AS 16.35.060 or the certificate required by AS 16.35.150 is fully executed and dated before the effective date of this Act.

* Sec. 3. This Act takes effect on the 15th day after its passage and approval or on the 15th day after it becomes law without approval.
