HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 4

Commending the University of Alaska administration for emergency services provided during the flood crisis.

BE IT RESOLVED

BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

WHEREAS the administration of the University of Alaska anticipated the severity of the Tanana Valley flood at an early state and quickly made housing and dining arrangements available for flood refugees; and

WHEREAS the University at one time was providing dining service to over 7,000 flood victims and provided shelter for a large number of people for many weeks; and

WHEREAS these services greatly lessened the amount of human suffering; and

WHEREAS, in particular, Mr. Al George of the University staff showed admirable concern and foresight in providing these services;

BE IT RESOLVED that the Legislature of the State of Alaska expresses its gratitude to and commendation of the administration of the University of Alaska for its meritorious service to the people of the Tanana Valley during the flood crisis, and particularly commends Mr. Al George of the University staff for his foresight in making emergency arrangements.
