## HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 45

Relating to a study of Alaska's role in the National Oceanics Program.

BE IT RESOLVED

BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

WHEREAS marine science development is one of the most vital concerns of the nation today; and

WHEREAS the need to make maximum use of the productive opportunities in the ocean is becoming increasingly urgent; and

WHEREAS there are a growing number of sound ocean-oriented operations developing rapidly across the country working in cooperation with each other and with the presidential Commission on Marine Science, Engineering and Resources; and

WHEREAS it is equally vital that Alaska play an active role in the national oceanographic program;

BE IT RESOLVED that the Legislative Council is directed to conduct a study in cooperation with governmental and private agencies and other persons concerned with facets of the subject in an effort to find the means and methods whereby Alaska, and particularly the University of Alaska, can play an increased role in the national oceanographic program; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED that the Legislative Council report its findings and recommendations to the Second Session of the Fifth Legislature.
