## HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 78

Relating to the leasing of space from the Alaska State Housing Authority.

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### BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

WHEREAS the Legislature, by Chapter 99, Session Laws of Alaska 1965, provided for the construction and acquisition by the Alaska State Housing Authority of public buildings for lease to the state; and

WHEREAS a leasing program has been entered into under the Act; and

WHEREAS AS 37.05.280 requires that any additional lease executed after January 1, 1966, which provides for a payment in excess of \$12,000 annually be approved by the Legislature; and

WHEREAS it is in the best interest of the state to enter into the additional leases set out in this resolution;

BE IT RESOLVED that use of the space be provided by leases of the following premises and leases of these premises from the Alaska State Housing Authority providing for payments in excess of \$12,000 annually is approved:

- (1) School Addition and Related Improvements at Glennallen.
- (2) Fish and Game Headquarters Station Complex at King Salmon.
- (3) Highways Shops at Petersburg, Homer, Livengood and Soldotna and Highways Laboratory Building at Juneau.
- (4) Combined Housing Facility at Bethel.
