JOINT RESOLUTION

Relating to the creation of a new Coast Guard District in Alaska.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

WHEREAS approximately 89 per cent of Alaska's fishing fleet tonnage now operates year-round; and

WHEREAS there are over 850 foreign vessels now fishing in the same or adjacent waters to those being fished by Alaska's fishing fleet;

BE IT RESOLVED that the Commandant of the United States Coast Guard is requested to create a new Coast Guard district for western Alaska waters with headquarters in Kodiak.

COPIES of this Resolution shall be sent to the Honorable Lyndon B. Johnson, President of the United States; Admiral Willard J. Smith, Commandant of the United States Coast Guard; and the Honorable E. L. Bartlett and the Honorable Ernest Gruening, U.S. Senators, and the Honorable Howard W. Pollock, U.S. Representative, members of the Alaska delegation in Congress.
