## HOUSE RESOLUTION NO. 16

Relating to the recent announcement by Alaska Steamship Company that it planned to discontinue service to the City of Cordova.

### BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES:

WHEREAS the growth and development of not only the Alaska coastal communities but the entire state depends upon continued sea commerce; and

WHEREAS the City of Cordova is one of the communities in Alaska which is extremely dependent upon sea commerce and particularly on the shipping service presently rendered by the Alaska Steamship Company; and

WHEREAS the Alaska Steamship Company has recently announced that it intends to discontinue direct scheduled service to the City of Cordova; and

WHEREAS the discontinuance of shipping service to Cordova would severely damage the economic structure of the community and greatly hamper its future growth and development;

BE IT RESOLVED that the House of Representatives protests the proposal of the Alaska Steamship Company to discontinue service to the City of Cordova.
