SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 25

Commending the Captain Cook Jaycees for their contribution to good government.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

WHEREAS the Captain Cook Jaycees have initiated this year a public service program designed to be of invaluable aid to the legislature and which consists of providing a means whereby private citizens may express their views on matters pending before the legislature; and

WHEREAS as a part of this project the Captain Cook Jaycees have already held public hearings on past, present, and pending legislation; and

WHEREAS they have compiled a compendium of testimony received from the public and have made recommendations regarding certain pending legislative matters; and

WHEREAS their report was presented personally in Juneau to all legislators from the Anchorage area and to the Governor by Richard W. McComb, President; Carl Brady, Jr., Project Chairman; and Ed Harter, all of the Captain Cook Jaycees; and

WHEREAS projects of this nature are of inestimable value to individual legislators and serve as a media for private individuals to express their views to the legislature;

BE IT RESOLVED that the Legislature of the State of Alaska commends the Captain Cook Jaycees for this valuable public service; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED that the Legislature of the State of Alaska

expresses its fervent wish that projects of this nature be an annual undertaking by not only the Captain Cook Jaycees, but by Jaycees in all communities.
