## SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 29

### BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

WHEREAS the Alaska Association of Insurance Agents has, year after year, contributed to Alaska State Offices and state-wide organizations for the continuation of Fire and Highway Programs for the safety of the public; and
