SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 35

Relating to newspapers furnished to the Legislature.

BE IT RESOLVED

BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

WHEREAS several Alaska publishing companies have made their newspapers available to the Legislature free of charge; and

WHEREAS this service has been of great value to the legislators by increasing the opportunity for each member to broaden his knowledge of statewide events and public opinion;

BE IT RESOLVED that the Legislature commends the following newspapers and sincerely thanks those responsible for making the papers available: KETCHIKAN DAILY NEWS, CORDOVA TIMES, THE FRONTIERSMAN, THE NOME NUGGET, FAIRBANKS NEWS MINER, ANCHORAGE DAILY NEWS, ANCHORAGE TIMES, JESSENS WEEKLY, JUNEAU EMPIRE, TUNDRA TIMES and THE POLAR STAR; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED that the Legislature commends those airlines who have transported the newspapers from their point of origin to Juneau at no charge to the legislators.
