JOINT RESOLUTION

Relating to a weather station at Fairbanks.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

WHEREAS weather information gathered in Fairbanks is sent to the Anchorage Weather Bureau before it is interpreted and relayed back to Fairbanks for dissemination; and

WHEREAS this procedure causes unnecessary aggravations and delays in the dissemination of weather information;

BE IT RESOLVED that the Weather Bureau is respectfully urged to establish a full fledged weather station at Fairbanks to eliminate any need for a relay of weather information to Anchorage before it is disseminated in the Fairbanks area.

Representative, members of the Alaska delegation in Congress.
