JOINT RESOLUTION

Commending and thanking the U. S. Army Corps of Engineers.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

WHEREAS, by Labor Day 1967, the U. S. Army Corps of Engineers had awarded 42 construction contracts, totalling \$3.25 million, for the rehabilitation of Fairbanks after the Tanana Valley flood disaster of 1967; and

WHEREAS the Corps' prompt and energetic efforts in other communities affected by the flood served to greatly alleviate the damage and hardship; and

WHEREAS the tireless services and leadership of individual members of the Corps provided invaluable assistance to the people of the stricken area;

BE IT RESOLVED that the Legislature of the State of Alaska warmly commends and thanks the U. S. Army Corps of Engineers and its members individually for services provided to the state.
