AN ACT

Requiring that the nature of the state's interest be specified in a notice of default of a trust deed foreclosure.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

* Section 1. AS 34.20.070 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:

(d) If the State of Alaska is a subsequent party, the notice of default must set out, with such particularity as reasonably available information will permit, the nature of the state's lien, including the name and address, if known, of the person whose liability created the lien, the amount shown on the lien document, the department of the state government involved, the recording district, and the book and page on which the lien was recorded.
