## AN ACT

Relating to the professions of guiding and outfitting; and providing for an effective date.

### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

\* Section 1. AS 16.05.330 is amended to read:

Sec. 16.05.330. LICENSES AND TAGS REQUIRED. It is unlawful, except as otherwise permitted in this chapter, for a person to engage in sport fishing including the taking of razor clams, hunting, trapping, fur dealing, fish, fur, or game farming, or taxidermy without the appropriate license or tag and without having them in his actual possession.

\* Sec. 2. AS 16.50.120(a)(3) is amended to read:

(3) a person to guide as defined in this chapter without being licensed under this chapter and without having the license in his actual possession;

\* Sec. 3. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage and approval or on the day it becomes law without approval.
