## AN ACT

Relating to false alarms.

### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

\* Section 1. AS 11.45 is amended by adding a new section to read:

Sec. 11.45.050. FALSE ALARMS. (a) A person who turns in a false alarm to fire fighting authorities or ambulance service operators knowing the alarm to be false, or who causes another to turn in such an alarm, upon conviction, is guilty of a misdemeanor and punishable by a fine not to exceed \$1,000, or by imprisonment in jail for not more than one year, or by both.

(b) In addition to the penalties in (a) of this section the court may in its discretion require restitution by the convicted person to the authority involved for any and all expenses incurred as a direct result of the false alarm.
