**AN ACT**

Providing for the labeling, grading and setting of standards for cleanliness and sanitation of milk and milk products, frozen desserts, and imitation milk and imitation milk products by the division of agriculture.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:**

\* Section 1. AS 03.05.020 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:

(5) promulgate, repeal, and amend regulations consistent with existing law for

(A) the labeling and grading of milk and milk products and standards of cleanliness and sanitation, to at least the minimum of current recommendations of the United States Public Health Service, for the operation of dairies selling, or offering for sale, milk or milk products;

(B) the production and sale of ice cream and allied frozen desserts;

(C) the production and sale of imitation milk and imitation milk products.

\* Sec. 2. AS 18.05.040(9) is amended to read:

(9) standards of cleanliness and sanitation in connection with the construction, operation and maintenance of a camp, cannery, food handling establishment, food manufacturing plant, mattress manufacturing establishment, industrial plant, school, barber shop, cosmetological establishment, soft drink establishment, beer and wine dispensaries, and for other similar establishments in which insanitation may create a condition causative of disease;
