AN ACT

Concerning the necessary years of service for a teacher to be eligible for deferred vested retirement.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

* Section 1. AS 14.25.137(a) is amended to read:

(a) A teacher is eligible for a deferred vested benefit if

(1) he terminates his employment after completing 10 years of membership service; and

(2) he does not withdraw his contributions to the retirement fund.
