AN ACT

Relating to eyeglasses and sunglasses; and providing for an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

* Section 1. AS 08.72 is amended by adding a new section to read:

Sec. 08.72.275. LENSES AND FRAMES FOR EYEGLASSES AND SUNGLASSES. (a) No person may fabricate, distribute, sell, exchange, deliver or have in his possession with intent to distribute, sell, exchange or deliver eyeglasses or sunglasses unless they are fitted with plastic lenses or with glass lenses which are tempered or case hardened. Glass lenses shall have a minimum thickness of two millimeters.

(b) No person may fabricate, distribute, sell, exchange, deliver or have in his possession with intent to distribute, sell, exchange or deliver eyeglasses or sunglasses having frames manufactured from cellulose nitrate or other highly flammable materials.

(c) A person who violates this section is punishable by a fine of not less than \$50 nor more than \$100.

* Sec. 2. The provisions of this bill take effect one year after date of passage.
