AN ACT

Appropriating for payment to merchants for food and equipment furnished by them to victims and flood rescue workers during the natural disaster of August 14, 1967; and providing for an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

* Section 1. The sum of \$140,184.17 is appropriated from the general fund for payment to the following merchants who provided food and equipment to victims and rescue workers during the natural disaster of August 14, 1967. This sum shall be available until September 30, 1968, and shall be distributed to the merchants listed below in amounts not exceeding those scheduled and subject to below listed requirements. Payment shall be made to each merchant upon certification by either the Fairbanks North Star Borough or the City of Fairbanks and the Department of Administration that reimbursement is claimed only for inventory of food or equipment supplied to disaster victims.
