AN ACT

Making the presence of minors in poolrooms lawful.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

* Section 1. AS 11.60.070 is amended to read:

Sec. 11.60.070. MINORS IN CARDROOMS. (a) It is unlawful for a minor under the age of 17 years to frequent or loiter in or about a public cardroom conducted for profit.

(b) A proprietor, keeper, manager, conductor, clerk or person having control of a cardroom or hall conducted for profit, who allows a minor under the age of 17 years to frequent or loiter in or about the cardroom or hall is guilty of a misdemeanor.

(c) A minor under the age of 17 years who frequents or loiters in or about a cardroom or hall conducted for profit is guilty of a misdemeanor.
