Relating to licensing of veterinarians; and providing for an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

* Section 1. AS 08.98.190 is repealed and re-enacted to read:

Sec. 08.98.190. FEES. The following fees shall be imposed under this chapter when applicable:

* Sec. 2. AS 08.98.200 is repealed and re-enacted to read:

Sec. 08.98.200. REINSTATEMENT OF LAPSED LICENSE. A person whose license has lapsed is entitled to have his license reinstated without taking an examination unless his license has remained lapsed more than five years.

* Sec. 3. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage and approval or on the day it becomes law without approval.
