AN ACT

Relating to the sale of intoxicating liquor.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

* Section 1. AS 04.15 is amended by adding a new section to read:

Sec. 04.15.110. SALE IN VIOLATION OF LOCAL OPTION. Notwithstanding any other provision of this chapter, a person who unlawfully sells or offers for sale an intoxicating liquor in an area where the local option election has made these activities illegal is, upon conviction, guilty of a misdemeanor and punishable by imprisonment for a period not to exceed one year, or by a fine not to exceed \$5,000, or by both.
