AN ACT

Prohibiting the use of the state seal for advertising or commercial purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

* Section 1. AS 11.60 is amended by adding a new section to read:

Sec. 11.60.225. IMPROPER USE OF STATE SEAL. (a) It is unlawful to use or make a die or impression of the state seal for any advertising or commercial purpose, unless written permission has first been obtained from the secretary of state.

(b) Violation of this section constitutes a misdemeanor, and upon conviction is punishable by a fine of not more than \$500, or by imprisonment for not more than six months, or by both.
