AN ACT

Concerning grounds for arrest by a state trooper without a warrant; and providing for an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

* Section 1. AS 12.25 is amended by adding a new section to read:

Sec. 12.25.035. ARREST WITHOUT WARRANT BY STATE TROOPER WHEN JUDICIAL OFFICER IS UNAVAILABLE. A state trooper may arrest a person without a warrant for a misdemeanor or for the violation of an ordinance when

- (1) the officer has reasonable grounds to believe that the person to be arrested has committed a misdemeanor or has violated an ordinance;
- (2) personal or property damage is likely to be done unless the person is immediately arrested; and
- (3) there is no known judicial office empowered to issue a warrant within a radius of 25 miles of the person to be apprehended.

* Sec. 2. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage and approval or on the day it becomes law without approval.
