AN ACT

Relating to centralized occupational and professional licensing; and providing for an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

* Section 1. AS 08.01.010 is amended by adding a new paragraph to read:

(16) Board of Construction Contractors.

* Sec. 2. AS 08.01.100 is amended to read:

Sec. 08.01.100. LICENSE RENEWAL, LAPSE AND REINSTATEMENT. (a) All licenses shall be renewed biennially on the dates set by the department with the approval of the respective board.

(b) A registration, license, permit or certificate requiring renewal to continue effective must be renewed on or before the date set by the department or it will lapse. A penalty of \$10 shall be charged in addition to all delinquent renewal fees for reinstatement of a registration, license, permit or certificate which remains lapsed for more than 60 days.

* Sec. 3. AS 08.04.430 is amended to read:

Sec. 08.04.430. EXPIRATION AND RENEWAL. Any permit or registration under secs. 390 - 420 of this chapter, unless revoked or suspended, shall be renewed biennially upon payment of a renewal fee in the same amount as the initial biennial fee.

* Sec. 4. AS 08.12.150 is repealed and re-enacted to read:
Sec. 08.12.150. REINSTATEMENT OF LAPSED LICENSE.

A lapsed license may be reinstated if it has not remained lapsed for more than five years

* Sec. 5. AS 08.68.220(c) is repealed and re-enacted to read:

(c) A fee of \$5 for each document shall be charged for certified copies of an official document on file with the board.

* Sec. 6. AS 08.88.241 is repealed and re-enacted to read:

Sec. 08.88.241. REINSTATEMENT OF LAPSED LICENSE. A licensee who was required to take an examination before receiving a license and whose license has lapsed for more than three years may be required to be re-examined prior to reinstatement.

* Sec. 7. The following laws are repealed: AS 08.12.140; AS 08.28.210; AS 08.32.080; AS 08.36.290(7); AS 08.68.250(a); and AS 08.72.180.

* Sec. 8. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage and approval or on the day it becomes law without approval.
