AN ACT

Relating to service of process on nonresident motorists.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

* Section 1. AS 09.05.020(a) is amended to read:

(a) The operation of a motor vehicle by a nonresident (or owned by a nonresident and operated by his express or implied consent) in the state is considered equivalent to an appointment of the commissioner of revenue by the nonresident as his attorney. The summons may be served on the commissioner in an action against the nonresident growing out of an accident or collision in which the vehicle is involved while being so operated. This operation is considered a signification of the nonresident's agreement that a summons against him which is so served has the same legal force as if served on him personally in the state.
