HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 10

Relating to a study of criminal penalties to be made by the Legislative Affairs Agency.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

WHEREAS the criminal penalties allowable under the laws of this state do not reflect a consistent approach to sentencing and fining and do not seem to be tailored to the specific offenses to which they relate; and

WHEREAS this consistency and appropriateness of penalties are essential to the proper administration of justice;

BE IT RESOLVED that the Legislative Affairs Agency is requested to review the criminal penalty provisions in the Alaska Statutes, paying particular attention to imprisonment under the Criminal Code, and report its findings and recommendations for legislation, if any, to the First Session of the Sixth Legislature.
