## HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 25

Commending the citizens of the Greater Juneau Borough.

### BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

WHEREAS during the Centennial year 1967 the people of Juneau, Douglas, and the rural areas of Greater Juneau Borough voluntarily taxed themselves approximately a third of a million dollars, and the residents of the City of Juneau contributed land of a like amount in value, as the local share of constructing a new State Historical Museum; and

WHEREAS during the Centennial year the museum was completed and on January 7, 1968 officially presented to all the people of the State of Alaska as a gift from Gastineau Channel residents; and

WHEREAS the museum building -- one of the outstanding such structures of Alaska and the entire Pacific Northwest -- resulted not only from tax dollars but from hours of dedicated work and devotion on the part of the Gastineau Channel Centennial Association and numerous individuals; and

WHEREAS the new Alaska State Museum is a project in which the entire state takes great and justifiable pride;

BE IT RESOLVED that the Legislature extends to the Gastineau Channel Centennial Association and all the citizens of the Greater Juneau area its special commendation and appreciation for their efforts in the creation and completion of the Alaska State Museum Building in Juneau.
