HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 46

Relating to the transplanting of caribou or reindeer and musk ox to Unalaska Island.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

WHEREAS the people of Unalaska need an additional source of food; and

WHEREAS unlike some nearby areas which are overstocked with reindeer or caribou and musk ox, Unalaska has no big game animals; and

WHEREAS transplanting caribou or reindeer and musk ox from nearby areas would be an easy and inexpensive task, would relieve the overstocked condition of these areas, and would provide Unalaska with game for food and big game hunting;

BE IT RESOLVED that the Governor is respectfully requested to direct the Department of Fish and Game to transplant reindeer or caribou and musk ox to Unalaska Island in order to provide game for food and big game hunting.
