## JOINT RESOLUTION

Relating to the establishment of a post office at Nickolai, Alaska.

---

### BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

WHEREAS communication facilities are important factors in the growth and development of populated areas of Alaska; and

WHEREAS the community of Nickolai, Alaska, has no post office; and

WHEREAS Nickolai is a community of over 90 persons who have been settled in the locale for the past five years; and

WHEREAS the town has an airstrip with air service once a week; and

WHEREAS the sending and receiving of mail is already a great problem, and will become more difficult with any increase in population;

BE IT RESOLVED that the Postmaster General is respectfully urged to establish a post office at Nickolai, Alaska.
