HOUSE RESOLUTION NO. 16

Relating to the press coverage of the Fifth Legislature, Second Session.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES:

WHEREAS the legislative process is of vital concern to and affects the lives of all Alaskans in all areas of the state; and

WHEREAS a well-informed public is the strongest bulwark of a true democracy; and

WHEREAS Alaskans, in order to keep informed on all stages of the current legislative process, must depend upon the accuracy and promptness of the news reporting in the daily and weekly newspapers; and

WHEREAS the accurate and prompt news reporting of the activities of the Legislature requires a highly specialized skill and talent on the part of the news reporters; and

WHEREAS the Second Session of the Fifth Legislature has enjoyed accurate, fair, and prompt news reporting of all of its processes and activities by means of the thorough and comprehensive news wire service coverage;
