SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 26

Relating to ferry rates on certain products on the Kodiak to Homer run.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

WHEREAS Kodiak Island and the mainland areas of the state have a growing agricultural industry; and

WHEREAS the state should do everything in its power to aid this growing industry; and

WHEREAS a simple and economically sound method to aid the agricultural industry in these areas would be to lower the ferry rates for agricultural products;

BE IT RESOLVED that the Governor is respectfully requested to direct the Division of Marine Transportation, consistent with the fact discovered through a study of the situation, to reduce as far as is feasible the ferry rates for the carrying of agricultural products and livestock between Kodiak and Homer on a space available basis.
