## SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 34

Relating to a radio communications network on the village level.

\*\*\*\*\*

### BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

WHEREAS the lack of a dependable 24-hour radio communications network in Alaska poses a serious health and safety problem; and

WHEREAS using a combination of radio services now provided by the Bureau of Indian Affairs and the National Guard makes intervillage communication difficult or impossible; and

WHEREAS a state radio network linking each village in Alaska would be of invaluable service in making possible weather reports, calls for medical aid, and other services necessary to life and safety in these isolated areas;

BE IT RESOLVED that the Legislature respectfully requests the Governor to direct the division of communications of the Department of Public Works to inventory stationary radios, their frequencies and to establish an integrated emergency radio network in Alaska.
