JOINT RESOLUTION

Relating to the retention of the present regulations which permit special VFR clearances.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

WHEREAS the people of Alaska depend on aircraft to provide the necessary transportation in this vast state; and

WHEREAS the record of the aircraft operators in Alaska for safety under the present regulations which permit special VFR clearances has been extremely good; and

WHEREAS, any change in the regulations permitting special VFR clearances would severely hamper aircraft operations in Alaska and have a detrimental effect on trade and commerce in the state without any apparent benefit being served;

BE IT RESOLVED that the Legislature of the State of Alaska respectfully requests that the Federal Aviation Agency retain the present regulations which permit special VFR clearances.
