JOINT RESOLUTION

Relating to the establishment of a post office at Kokhanok, Alaska.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

WHEREAS the Village of Kokhanok, Alaska, located on Iliamna Lake, has been without a post office facility for several years; and

WHEREAS Kokhanok has increased in population to the point where a post office would serve the needs of over 100 persons; and

WHEREAS there are now individuals residing there who are capable and desirous of managing a post office;

BE IT RESOLVED that the Postmaster General is respectfully urged to establish a post office at Kokhanok, Alaska.

COPIES of this Resolution shall be sent to The Honorable Lawrence F. O'Brien, Postmaster General of the United States; and to The Honorable E.L. Bartlett and The Honorable Ernest Gruening, U.S. Senators, and The Honorable Howard W. Pollock, U.S. Representative, members of the Alaska delegation in Congress.
