JOINT RESOLUTION

Relating to the immediate installation of an airport control tower at Kenai.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

WHEREAS recent years have brought a great increase in both the population and industry on the Kenai Peninsula; and

WHEREAS this increase has brought with it an enormous influx of air travel and transportation; and

WHEREAS this increase in population, industry, development and air travel necessitates the constant upgrading of airport facilities in the Kenai area for the safety and well-being of all concerned; and

WHEREAS an airport control tower is vitally needed at Kenai if it is to provide the safe flying conditions that are required by any progressive state;

BE IT RESOLVED that the Alaska State Legislature respectfully requests the Department of Transportation and the Federal Aviation Agency to install an airport control tower at Kenai immediately.
