## HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 8

Relating to the appointment of a representative from Alaska to the Presidential Prayer Breakfast.

### BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

WHEREAS the strength of an individual, community, state or nation is relative to and dependent on spiritual values and faith in a Supreme Being; and

WHEREAS in recognition of the source of that strength, President Nixon has invited the governors of the fifty states and other national leaders, as well as heads of state from all parts of the world, to join him in a Presidential Prayer Breakfast on January 30, 1969; and

WHEREAS it is fitting and proper that Alaska be represented and join our President and leaders of the world in prayer; and

WHEREAS Governor Miller has appointed Jack R. Simpson to represent the Governor and the State of Alaska at the Presidential Prayer Breakfast;

BE IT RESOLVED that the Legislature of the State of Alaska concurs in the appointment of Jack R. Simpson to represent the Governor, the Legislature, and the citizens of the State of Alaska at this unique and commendable prayer breakfast. In doing so, the Legislature invites and encourages all the citizens of the state to join President Nixon in the spirit and attitude of prayer, asking God to dwell in the hearts of all men and their leaders so that love and truth will motivate and govern the actions of men and nations and so that government by prejudice, hatred, and force will disappear from this earth.
