AN ACT

Relating to per diem for state employees; and providing for an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

* Section 1. AS 39.20.110 is amended to read:

Sec. 39.20.110. PER DIEM ALLOWANCE. Officials and employees of the state agencies, while traveling on official business and away from their designated post of duty, shall be allowed, instead of their actual expenses for subsistence and all fees or tips, a per diem allowance to be prescribed by the commissioner of administration under the regulatory authority set out in sec. 160 of this chapter, and in consultation with the head of the agency concerned, not to exceed the rate of \$30 for travel inside or outside the state.

* Sec. 2. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage and approval or on the day it becomes law without approval.
