## AN ACT

Relating to drilling permits; and providing for an effective date.

### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

\* Section 1. AS 31.05.090 is amended to read:

Sec. 31.05.090. PERMITS AND FEES TO DRILL WELLS. A person desiring to drill a well in search of oil or gas shall notify the department of his intent on a form prescribed by the department and shall pay a fee of \$100 for a permit for each well sought to be drilled. Upon receipt of notification and fee, the department shall promptly issue a permit to drill, unless the drilling of the well is contrary to law or a regulation or order of the department, or unless the person is in violation of a department regulation, order or stipulation pertaining to drilling, plugging or abandonment of a well. The drilling of a well is prohibited until a permit to drill is obtained in accordance with this chapter.

\* Sec. 2. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage and approval or on the day it becomes law without approval.
