AN ACT

Relating to water quality; and providing for an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

* Section 1. AS 46.05.230(5) is amended to read:

(5) "pollution" means the contamination or altering of waters of the state in a manner which creates a nuisance or makes waters unclean, or noxious, or impure, or unfit so that they are actually or potentially harmful or detrimental or injurious to public health, safety or welfare, to domestic, commercial, industrial, or recreational use, or to livestock, wild animals, bird, fish, or other aquatic life;

* Sec. 2. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage and approval or on the day it becomes law without approval.
