AN ACT

Relating to the Alcoholic Beverage Control Board.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

* Section 1. AS 04.05.010(a) is amended to read:

(a) There is established an Alcoholic Beverage Control Board within the Department of Revenue consisting of five members appointed for overlapping three-year terms. The board is vested with the duties, powers, and responsibilities involved in the control of alcoholic beverages, including the promulgation of rules and regulations and the hearing of appeals from the action of officers and employees charged with enforcing the alcoholic beverage control laws, rules, and regulations. The governor shall appoint the board subject to confirmation by the legislature. No member of the board may hold any other state or federal office, either elective or appointive. Two members of the board shall be actively engaged in the alcoholic beverage industry, except that no member may be an officer, agent, or employee of a wholesale alcoholic beverage enterprise. No three members of the board may be engaged in the same business, occupation or profession. Three members shall constitute a quorum for the conduct of business. The board shall meet at least once each year in each of the four judicial districts to study, reconsider and modify existing agency rules and regulations in the light of current local problems.
