AN ACT

Permitting the public racing of snow vehicles, automobiles and motorcycles on state highways under certain conditions.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

* Section 1. AS 28.10.040 is amended by adding a new paragraph to read:

(6) snow vehicles, automobiles and motorcycles which are permitted to race under AS 05.35.

* Sec. 2. AS 5 is amended by adding a new chapter to read:

CHAPTER 35. PUBLIC RACING.

Sec. 05.35.010. WHEN RACING IS PERMITTED. To the extent that it is consistent with federal law and regulations, snow vehicles, automobiles and motorcycles may be operated on state highways for special racing events of limited duration which are conducted according to a pre-arranged schedule under permit as provided for in sec. 20 of this chapter.

Sec. 05.35.020. PERMITS FOR RACING EVENTS. The athletic commission may issue, and for cause cancel, a permit to conduct a snow vehicle, automobile or motorcycle racing event as provided in this chapter under terms and conditions and at times and places the commission may determine. If the commission refuses to grant a permit to an applicant, or cancels a permit, the applicant or holder of the cancelled permit may, upon application, have a hearing under the provisions of the Administrative Procedure Act (AS 44.62). No permit may be issued by the commission for the use of a state highway without the concurrence of the commissioner of highways and the commissioner of public safety.

* Sec. 3. AS 05.30.080 is amended by adding a new paragraph to read:

(4) an exhaust muffler in good working order except at the operator's option when participating in an event permitted under AS 05.35.
