AN ACT

Providing for compensation for members of the Workmen's Compensation Board; and providing for an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

* Section 1. AS 23.30.005(c) is amended to read:

(c) The governor shall appoint the management member of the southern panel for a term of four years, and the labor member for a term of three years. He shall appoint the management member of the northern panel for a term of three years, and the labor member for a term of four years. The management and labor members are entitled to compensation in the amount of \$50 a day for each day or portion of a day spent in actual meeting or on authorized official business incident to their duties and to all other transportation and per diem as provided by law.

* Sec. 2. This Act takes effect July 1, 1970.
