## AN ACT

Relating to state-operated schools; amending ch. 46 SLA 1970; and providing for an effective date.

### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

- \* Section 1. Sec. 34, ch. 46 SLA 1970 is amended to read:

Sec. 34. AS 14.07.030(2) - (4) and 14.07.040 are repealed, effective July 1, 1971.

- \* Sec. 2. AS 14.07.050(a) is amended to read:

(a) Textbooks for use in the public schools of the state shall be selected by district boards for district schools and by a State Schools Textbook Committee appointed by the director for state schools. Selections of the State Schools Textbook Committee shall be submitted to the Board of Directors for State-Operated Schools for approval or rejection.

- \* Sec. 3. AS 14.07.160(b) is amended to read:

(b) The bylaws shall be written and distributed in a manner so as to be readily available to personnel of the department.

- \* Sec. 4. Secs. 4 - 6, ch. 46 SLA 1970 are repealed.

\* Sec. 5. Secs. 1, 2 and 4 of this Act take effect on the day after its passage and approval or on the day it becomes law without approval.

- \* Sec. 6. Sec. 3 of this Act takes effect July 1, 1971.
